Eligibility Criteria to attend the FDP: Faculty Member must have attended at least one Level-1 8 Day FDP on "Universal Human Values and Professional Ethics", organized by Value education cell AKTU, Lucknow.

Note: Preference will be given to those faculties who attended one refresher FDP along with Level-1 FDP on Universal Human Values.

Fee of FDP: There is no fee to attend the FDP.

Advantages of the certificate of this FDP:

1. The certified Faculty members would be eligible to teach these open elective courses to be offered as open elective in B.Tech.
2. The certified Faculty members would be eligible to evaluate the answer sheets of the courses.
3. They will contribute in periodic resource material and content development.
