Scholarship Policy

Approved by All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE)
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The institute provides various resources to assist financially needy students. Scholarships from the State Government, Central Government, and the Institute are made available through the Department of Student Welfare. Below are the scholarship schemes offered to students according to eligibility criteria.

1. U.P. Government Scholarship

The Institute helps and promotes the student of economically weaker backgrounds to pursue professional courses and come into the mainstream of society.

Requirements and Eligibility for U.P. Government Scholarship:

1. **Regular** students of the **SC/ST** categories “**whose parental Total Annual Income does not exceed Rs. 2.5 lakhs**” as per the notification of the Social Welfare Department, U.P. Government.
2. **Regular** students of the **General** category “**whose parental Total Annual Income does not exceed Rs. 2 lakhs**” as per the notification of the Social Welfare Department, U.P. Government.
3. **Regular** students of the **OBC** category “**whose parental Total Annual Income does not exceed Rs. 2 lakhs**” as per the notification of the Other Backwards Classes Welfare Department, U.P. Government.
4. **Regular** students of the **Minority** category “**whose parental Total Annual Income does not exceed Rs. 2 lakhs**” as per the notification of the Minority Welfare Department, U.P. Government.

- **The students are also required to fill in their Aadhaar Card No. and Mobile No. (as linked with their Bank Account No.) positively in their above Scholarship Forms.**

Documents needed for the scholarship

(FOR SC/ST/GENERAL/OBC/MINORITY CATEGORY)

As per the instructions of the Social Welfare Department, Other Backwards Classes Welfare Department and Minority Welfare Department, U.P. Government, the following documents are required to apply for the Scholarship:

1. Photocopy of the allotment letter issued by AKTU for admission in the Institute.
2. The photo will be scanned and affixed to the Online Scholarship Form.
3. Attested Income Certificate along with the original issued by the Competent Authority for verification, along with a copy of the latest Internet Income Certificate generated from the Website of the U.P. Govt.
4. Attested Caste Certificate along with the original issued by the Competent Authority for verification, along with a copy of the latest Internet Caste Certificate generated from the Website of the U.P. Govt.
5. Attested Domicile Certificate for Residential Proof along with the original not older than five years from the date of admission, issued by the Competent Authority, along with a copy of the latest Internet Domicile Certificate generated from the Website of the U.P. Govt.
6. Photocopy of Pass-out Mark Sheet of Class X, XII and B.Tech or any other Course – Ist Year/ IInd Year/ IIInd Year.
7. Photocopy of the fee receipt of the student for the last Academic Year. If the student is a hostler, then a copy of the receipt of the Hostel Fee is required to be attached.
8. Photocopy of Bank Passbook. (Any Nationalised Bank of UP State)
9. Non-Judicial Stamp of Rs. 10/-, Notarised affidavit if there is a gap between two classes.



10. An Affidavit by the student on a Non-Judicial Stamp of Rs. 10/- (Annexure "Cha") giving his/her full particulars as required in the above Annexure-"Cha" and mentioning that he/she is giving a separate Affidavit for the gap period, if any.

11. Declaration that the annual income of his/her Parents/Guardian does not exceed the prescribed limit and he/she has been admitted in this institution without paying any Tuition Fee for the last Academic Year, and the details mentioned in the Certificate attached with the application form are true and correct. If any error/mistake is found therein, he/she shall be responsible for it (Annexure "Kha-1").

12. Self-declaration of 75% attendance.

13. Photocopy of Aadhaar Card.

14. In Renewal Form Cases Enrollment No. must be mentioned in the Scholarship Form.

2. Student Welfare Fund (by Institute)

The Student Welfare Fund has been established in BBDNIIT for the benefit of meritorious students with economically weaker backgrounds.

- The main purpose of this fund is to provide scholarships for needy students.
- The students from Second Year onwards only can avail this scholarship.

How to Apply:

Students can submit a duly filled application form along with an income certificate of the parent and the marksheet of the previous semesters to the Office of the DSW on any working day as per the notification for the applicable session circulated separately.



Eligibility Criteria:

The applications are selected based on the following criteria:

- a. Merit:** Applications will be shortlisted based on the results of previous semesters/year, and those who have secured more than 70% and are not getting a scholarship of any other category.
- b. Family income:** While shortlisting the application, the annual income of the family, the number of earning members and dependents, etc., will be considered.

3. Merit Scholarship (by Institute)

A. FOR AKTU Affiliated College

(i) A 25% scholarship (on tuition fees) for all years will be provided to students willing to enrol in B.Tech programs in ECE/EE/ME/Civil Engineering at BBDNIIT. To be eligible for or maintain this scholarship from the second year onwards, students must maintain a minimum class attendance of 75%. Failure to meet this attendance requirement will result in the discontinuation of the scholarship.

(ii) A 25% scholarship (on tuition fees) in the first year only will be awarded to candidates enrolling in PG courses (except M.Pharm) if they have completed their UG from the same college.

B. SCHOLARSHIP OF EMPLOYEE QUOTA for BBDNIIT

(i) A 15% scholarship (on tuition fees) for any course at **BBDNIIT** will be awarded to the ward (son/daughter) of any employee of BBDNIIT if their service period is more than 3 years (without a break). To avail of or continue



this scholarship from the second year onwards, the student must maintain a minimum class attendance of 75%. Failure to meet this attendance requirement will result in the discontinuation of the scholarship.

(ii) A 20% scholarship (on tuition fees) for any course at **BBDNIIT** will be provided to the ward (son/daughter) of any employee of BBDNIIT if their service period is more than 5 years (without a break). To avail of or continue this scholarship from the second year onwards, the student must maintain a minimum class attendance of 75%. Failure to meet this attendance requirement will result in the discontinuation of the scholarship.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

A student enrolled at BBDNIIT can avail only one type of SCHOLARSHIP (including Government Scholarships) in a single session of their studies. No two types of SCHOLARSHIPS can be combined. Any claim in this regard will not be entertained.

4. AICTE YASHASVI (YOUNG ACHIEVERS' SCHOLARSHIP AND HOLISTIC ACADEMIC SKILLS VENTURE INITIATIVE)

A. OBJECTIVE OF THE SCHEME:

The field of higher education is currently undergoing a transformative phase in order to adapt to global trends. The National Education Policy (NEP) of 2020 serves as a guiding light for this transformative journey. It is needless to mention that the core branches of engineering play a pivotal role in the growth of manufacturing industries. In order to motivate students to pursue engineering education at the diploma and UG levels in the core branches of engineering, AICTE has formulated a scholarship scheme for meritorious students seeking admission in the core branches of Engineering. The scheme



being implemented by AICTE aims for encouraging student to pursue technical education in core branches of engineering, i.e. Civil, Chemical, Electrical, Electronic and Mechanical Engineering in AICTE-approved technical institutions.

B. SALIENT FEATURES:

- Applicable to candidates admitted to the first year of a Degree/Diploma level course in any of the AICTE-approved institutions of the respective year.
- For Degree-level students, Rs. 50,000/- per annum for every year of study, i.e., a maximum of 4 years for first-year admitted students.
- For Diploma-level students, Rs. 30,000/- per annum for every year of study, i.e., a maximum of 3 years for first-year admitted students.
- After selection, the awardee will be paid a scholarship through DBT mode on an annual basis.

C. PROCEDURE FOR APPLYING:

- 1) The candidate fulfilling the eligibility conditions is required to apply online on the National Scholarship Portal (NSP) after the initiation of the application process, and the notice is published on the AICTE website.
- 2) The host institution where the candidate is studying is required to verify the online application.
- 3) The Department of Technical Education (DTE) of the respective State/ UT will verify these applications as the second level of scrutiny.

D. NUMBER OF SCHOLARSHIPS:

- 1) A total of 5,200 scholarships (2,593 for degree courses and 2,607 for diploma courses) are earmarked per annum under this scheme for students



pursuing First year of Degree/Diploma level engineering course in any of the AICTE approved Institutions.

2) State/Union Territory wise distribution of 5,200 scholarships (2,593 for degree courses and 2,607 for diploma courses) is as per Annexure-A.

E. CRITERIA OF SELECTION:

Degree Level Students:

1. The selection of candidates will be carried out solely on the basis of the merit of the qualifying qualification (12th grade) to pursue the Technical Degree Core branch of Engineering from any of the AICTE-approved institutions.
2. Selection of candidates under lateral entry will be on the basis of the average consolidated percentage of Marks in all 6 semesters. Limited to 10% of the total seat allocation in the respective states.
3. In case the number of scholarships per state-wise allotment is below 10 as per the calculation, the Competent Authority approved to ascertain minimum 10 number of scholarship in the state.
4. State/UT wise merit list will be prepared as per the number of scholarships allotted in point number 'D' above.

5. AICTE SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME

The AICTE **Pragati** Scholarship Scheme for **girl students**, the AICTE **Saksham** Scholarship Scheme for **specially-abled students** and the AICTE **Swanath** Scholarship Scheme for **encouragement and support to orphans, wards of**



parents died due to Covid-19, wards of Armed Forces and Central Paramilitary Forces martyred in action (Shaheed) to pursue education, are applicable as per the notifications of the AICTE from time to time. 6. Chhatra Kalyan Nidhi (by AKTU)

Nidhi Guidelines-

- 1: Student have to apply for CKN within 90 days after father/earning parent dies in or due to an accident or otherwise.
- 2: Financial assistance will be provided to student to continue his/her studies.
- 3: Uploaded documents should be verified by the Director/Principal of the Institute/College. Verification of documents by other than Director/Principal will not be considered.
- 4: Hard copy of uploaded documents on ERP along with Affidavit/Undertaking (in Original) should be sent to Dean Student Welfare, AKTU, Lucknow.
- 5: All the required documents should be of relevant session, i.e., session for which assistance is being claimed.
- 6: Application may not be considered if the documents uploaded on University ERP are found incorrect/irrelevant. Onus for not considering the case will be



held on Institute/Student itself. None documents will be accepted after passing University final year exam.
